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HIGH STREET BRIDGE CLOSURES EXPECTED FOR BRIDGE REHABILITATION WORK

ALAMEDA COUNTY – The Alameda County Public Works Agency will begin rehabilitation and bridge deck repair work on the High Street Bridge, which connects the cities of Oakland and Alameda, on Monday, March 2, 2015. This repair work will require the High Street Bridge to be CLOSED to vehicle traffic Monday through Friday, from 9:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., lasting approximately seven weeks. There will also be some limitations to marine traffic. The US Coast Guard will communicate this information in its weekly “Coast Guard Local Notices to Mariners.”

Detour signs will be in place to guide motorists around the bridge closures. When travelling through the detour areas, motorists are advised to exercise caution and adhere to all traffic regulations.

This schedule is subject to change. Additional information will be provided for subsequent phases.
