CLOSE OF REGISTRATION FOR JUNE 7, 2016 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

The **deadline to register to vote** for the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election is **Monday**, **May 23, 2016**.

Alameda County residents must be United States citizens, 18 years old and not in prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony to be eligible to register to vote.

Voter registration affidavits are available at the Registrar of Voters office and at libraries, fire stations and post offices. You may also complete the registration form online at www.registertovote.ca.gov. Completed affidavits must be delivered to the Registrar of Voters office at 1225 Fallon Street, Room G-1, Oakland, CA 94612 or postmarked by May 23, 2016 in order to be valid for this election.
