ANNOUNCES WEEKEND VOTING HOURS

The Alameda County Registrar of Voters will be open for weekend voting to allow voters to come to the Registrar of Voters' office to vote early for the **June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election** on the following weekend days:

- **Saturday, May 28, 2016 and Sunday, May 29, 2016 from 9:00a.m. – 3:00p.m.**
- **Saturday, June 4, 2016 and Sunday, June 5, 2016 from 9:00a.m. – 3:00p.m.**

Registrar of Voters' staff will also be outside of 1225 Fallon Street, Oakland, at the corner of 13th and Fallon Streets, to assist voters who choose to drop off their voted Vote by Mail ballot at the new **Ballot Drop Stop!**

The office is currently open for voting Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Registrar of Voters' office also will be open on **Election Day, Tuesday, June 7, 2016** from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters' office is located **inside** the René C. Davidson Court House at 1225 Fallon Street Room G-1, Oakland, CA. Voters wishing to cast ballots during weekend hours will be able to access the Registrar of Voters office by using the 12th Street entrance of the Court House.
