The Summer Reading Game is a nationwide celebration that encourages reading and lifelong learning. Summer reading programs engage children and teens with reading and other learning activities over the summer. <u>Research</u> suggest that students who participate in summer reading programs avoid summer learning loss. This year's game "Read for the Win" incorporates a sports and achievement theme and is open to all ages from newborns, children, teens, adults, and seniors. The all-ages game is fun, free, and easy to play.

You can play the game <u>online</u>, with a game board, or both. Players earn points and prizes by reading and completing various activities. The more you read, the more chances you can win. **Teens and adults who complete the game are automatically entered into a drawing to win the following prizes:**

- Go-Pro Camera (for teens)
- FitBit (for adults)
