**ALAMEDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO COMMEND
GOLDEN STATE WARRIORS FOR WINNING NBA CHAMPIONSHIP**

Officials with the Golden State Warriors will attend today's meeting of the Alameda County Board of Supervisors as the Board commends the team for winning its second National Basketball Association championship in three years.

A commendation will be presented to team officials at noon today in the Board chambers, 5th floor, 1221 Oak Street, Oakland.

The commendation celebrates the team's recent run of success and some record-breaking performances, including a 14-game regular season win streak in March and April and a 16-1 record in the 2017 postseason.

The commendation notes that the Warriors have played games at the Oakland-Alameda County Complex, now known as Oracle Arena, since 1966, and have become a "a source of great pride for Alameda County and the Bay Area." It also praises the team for its numerous community contributions, including sponsorship of literacy and health programs for youth and its Warriors Foundation, which provides financial assistance to nonprofit organizations.
