Title/Subject Description: Reentry/Realignment Meetings

Background/Recommendation/Action to be Taken:

1. In order to promote Civic/Community Engagement the CAB recommends, CCP and the CCPEC hold one of its quarterly meetings after business hours so that justice impacted people who work or go to school can attend. Currently, since meetings are held during the day and most providers, non-profits, and governmental employees are paid to attend, returning citizens/residents are at a huge disadvantage because they would have to lose money in order to attend. For the work groups, Fiscal and Procurement work Group, and Programs and Services Work Group, Process and Evaluation Work Group which are meeting monthly, we recommend that 25% of their meetings be also held after business hours at various re-entry non-profits so that working returnees can participate and generate input in order to shape and influence policy. In order to acknowledge the specific needs of men, women, families, single parents and so on, we suggest a day-care or babysitter and transportation stipends in order to encourage engagement.
2. Justification for these recommendations is based upon "Article 2 Duties and Powers, Section 1 which holds, "CAB shall advise and make recommendations to the Alameda County Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) Executive Committee (EC) by providing input on community needs; assessing implementation of the Realignment plan; reviewing data on Realignment outcomes; advising the CCP/EC on community engagement strategies."
