- Group Discussion
  - MH Subcommittee priorities: what was achieved during FY 21/22
    - Provide discharge planning for all individuals with known MH needs within the Alameda County jails.
      - Ensuring that the discharge plans are getting to the clients.
    - To evaluate and enhance evidence based and culturally related practices.
      - Making sure that the discharge planning team are representative of the community that they are serving and diversity of those teams.
    - Enhancing the continuum of care for M2M and SMI clients through dedicated informational sharing channels.
  - Identify SMART goals for FY 22/23 using SIM as a guide
    - Dedicating investments towards community Mental Health
    - Making sure that the discharge planning team are representative of the community that they are serving and diversity of those teams.
    - Ensuring that the discharge plans are getting to the clients.
  - Juan provided AFBH Post Release Form for the groups feedback.
    - It was suggested to include a section for additional resources such as the Probation phone number on the form. Corrine will provide the Probation contact information to Juan to be included onto the form.
    - Form will be translated to the top languages once finalized.
    - Additional support resources were also suggested to include on the form such a Safe Landing and housing programs.
