An artificial intelligence expert and venture capitalist, Kai Fu Lee said that he believes 40% of the world's jobs will be replaced by robots capable of automating tasks.

Impacted jobs include both blue collar and white collar professions. "Many jobs that seem a little bit complex, chef, waiter, a lot of things will become automated."

Elon Musk, who has warned about the power of artificial intelligence—worry that automation could disrupt entire communities and disproportionately affect low-income workers.




