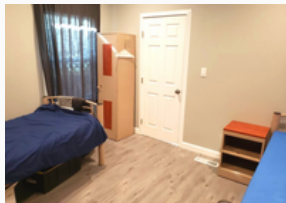

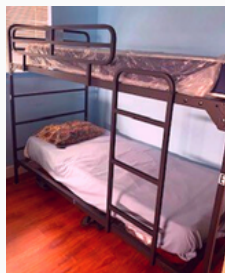

- Random drug testing; rules and curfew



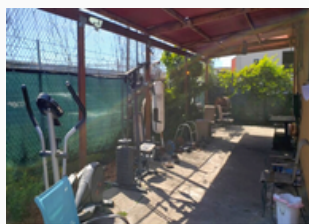

- Case management; support with permanent housing, employment, substance abuse, & education

Updated July 2023

ACPD offers different transitional housing programs to AB 109 eligible clients as temporary housing assistance with the end goal of securing permanent housing. Restrictions may apply.

AB 109 Eligibility:

- Post-Release Community Supervision (PRCS)
- PC 1170(h) including: split sentences, mandatory supervision, and deferred entry of judgement in lieu of AB-109 eligible offense
- Formal Probationers
- Pretrial Program Participants
- Specialty Court Participants (felony convictions)
- AB1950 Clients (impacted by retroactive application of legislation)

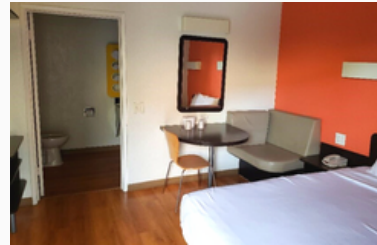

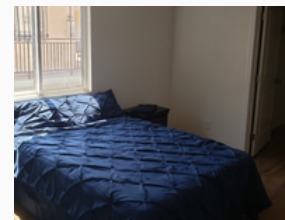

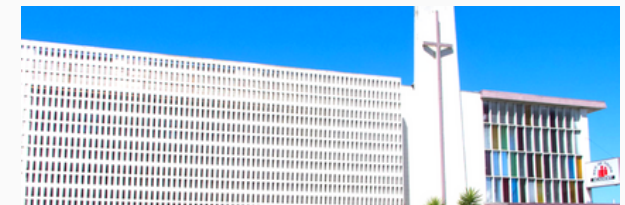
