- 5. Allocation Spreadsheet Overview Janene Grigsby
 - a. Total Remaining Unallocated Funds (as of this meeting) = \$3,302,718 (pg. 2, line 76)

- 6. Funding Request: Genesis Worship Center Fresh Start Academy
 - a. This recommendation is for \$36,400 to pay for additional staff to cover the 24 hours/7 days a week security system at Genesis Worship Center Fresh Start Academy, which provides transitional housing; current contract term (12/1/2020 11/30/2023) and total contract amount is \$2,005,858
 - b. The fiscal impact would be \$32,185 (total unallocated contract amount = \$4,215)
