- 1. Call to Order and Introductions Meeting was called to order at 3:01 PM
- 2. Determination of Ongoing Need for Virtual Meetings Under AB 361, Filed 9/16/21 Continuation of virtually held meetings for 30 days approved by the workgroup
- 3. Public Comment
- Review and Adoption of <u>Fiscal and Procurement Meeting Minutes 4-5-2022</u> Minutes reviewed and approved as written
- 5. Funding Request:
 - a. \$2.25M for Employment Vendor Pool Contract Extension through March 31, 2023 Gina Temporal
 - This request is to increase allocation of the current Employment Vendor Pool contract in order to continue funding employment services through March 31, 2023 (current term is 4/1/2020 – 3/31/23)
 - ii. Current allocation is \$6 million (M) (\$1M for increase subsidized hours was placed in trust in FY18/19); this request includes using the \$1M in trust, which leaves a fiscal impact of a little over \$1M for FY22/23
 - iii. There are currently 8 providers: The Youth Employment Partnership (YEP), La Familia, Building Opportunities for Self-Sufficiency (BOSS), Tricities, Lao Family, Center for Employment Opportunities (CEO), and Success Centers; Rubicon has been added and will provide services from Hayward
 - iv. Data for the last fiscal year is in the <u>CCP FY 2021-22 Annual Plan</u> (there is a gap from 7/21-12/21)
 - v. Item will be moved to the next CCPEC meeting for consideration/approval
- 6. Contracts Update Gina Temporal
 - a. Employment Vendor Pool No bids were received for Round 10; the vendor pool has been closed

- b. <u>Alameda County (AC) Reentry Housing Vendor Pool / Cognitive Behavior Intervention Services, Incentives,</u> <u>and Innovation Program</u> – Bids are under evaluation
- c. Contracts is working with General Services Agency (GSA) on the Request For Proposals (RFP) that have been moved forward; no new RFPs were moved forward in April, but Contracts is working with GSA to get timelines on each of these projects in order to provide estimates of when RFPs will be released
