 - a. <u>Alameda County Reentry Housing Vendor Pool</u> Round 5: Three bids received and under review for evaluation
 - b. <u>Submitted to General Services Agency (GSA)</u> Several projects were submitted to GSA and being worked on; projects scheduled for a June release CORE, Client Resource Forum Coordinator, and Early Intervention Court
 - c. Forecasting A funding request for Family Reunification is tentatively scheduled for January 2023

 - a. <u>FY16/17 to FY18/19 Funds Available for Reinvestment</u> = \$902,464
 - b. FY19/20 Funds Available for Reinvestment = \$1,618,326
 - c. FY20/21 Funds Available for Reinvestment = \$618,326
 - d. FY21/22 Funds Available for Reinvestment = \$668,326
 - e. FY22/23 Funds Available for Reinvestment = \$668,326

 - g. <u>Discussion</u>: (i) There was a question about the difference between the Housing Vendor Pool and CDA Housing (the AC Housing Pool focus is on transitional housing; CDA is rapid rehousing (works to get client housing in the community, a housing stipend, and some case management) and shelter beds); (ii) A question was asked if Career Technical Education (CTE) is part of the 1400 Jobs Initiative. It is not, it is a separate program. 1400 Jobs has been renamed the Reentry Hiring Initiative and it creates pathways into government and private sector employment; CTE connects clients to educational opportunities within employment fields they are interested in
