Process and Evaluation Workgroup meetings are informative, insightful, and full of free-flowing discussions, supporting creative ideas from community members with a focus on providing solutions to the challenges faced by friends and family returning home. Currently, the Workgroup is developing a process to improve how services provided for Probation clients are evaluated. Add your voice to our participants who have the vision to turn creative ideas into initiatives that help our returning citizens thrive.

Prior successes include:

- Advocating for Santa Rita Jail inmates to become enrolled in Medi-Cal prior to release.
- Amending the Santa Rita clearance policy to allow more formerly incarcerated individuals who provide services to enter the jail.
- Amending the process to request Probation funding to service clients.

The meeting will be virtual, and the agenda is designed to allow newcomers to get an understanding of the Workgroup activities, ask questions, and hopefully start attending future meetings regularly.
