Free Our Kids (FOK) Coalition Proposal Presentation and Discussion	<p>Please see attached presentation PowerPoint</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Questions & Answers</p> <p>What were the results of the FOK meetings with Chief Still? What feedback was received from Public Protection Committee? <i>The hope was that that there would be an assessment and a work group could be formed. The FOK scope is larger than that of the SB 823 Committee.</i></p> <p>Should the JJCC or the subcommittee bring this to the BOS? Because the FOK proposal is mentioned in the subcommittee's plan, the subcommittee would have the authority to move the plan forward to the Board.</p> <p>What was the Public Protection Committee's response to your presentation? What is the next step? <i>The PPC was deferential to Probation and asked that the plan be brought to the SB 823 Subcommittee.</i></p> <p>Chief Dawal clarified that Probation has a certain number of positions on the books. He advised that many are not filled. Due to the numerous vacancies, the staff ratios presented in the FOK report are not accurate. Probation is planning to fill vacancies and increase staffing for the more comprehensive SB 823 programming.</p>
