<u>Pre-Release Planning & Case Management</u>: Reentry service navigation is important to ensure clients have a successful transition from incarceration to Probation supervision in the community and subsequent discharge from Probation. This service will provide Reentry service specialists with knowledge of a wide range of reentry services to help guide clients to services and programs that match their individual.
