

Strategy #2: School Based Violence Prevention

- Proposed OUSD Office of Violence Intervention and Prevention & Youth Justice (OVIPYJ)
 - Violence Intervention & Prevention Teams at 7 High Schools
 - Coordination with OUSD, City of Oakland, AC Probation, Diversion Programs
 - Provide training to school site leadership, staff, and Violence Intervention & Prevention teams
 - Support each high school principal in developing and implementing a comprehensive school-wide violence prevention plan
 - Provide guidance and technical assistance to school sites as needed

Proposed: Office of Violence Intervention and Prevention & Youth Justice (OVIPYJ)

Purpose: coordinate a collaboration of CBOs, public agencies, and school communities using proven and effective means to reduce violence in OUSD.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate with public safety agencies such as the Oakland's DVP and Alameda County Probation Department
- Coordinate violence prevention services and supports for OUSD secondary schools
- Provide training to school site leadership, staff, and Violence Intervention and Prevention Teams
- Support each high school principal in developing and implementing a comprehensive school-wide violence prevention plan
- Provide guidance and technical assistance to school sites as needed
- Coordinate and implement targeted interventions (e.g. Lifting the Bar)
