NEW BUSINESS

1. Alameda County Updates: Chief needs to know what type of CJIS is eligible to fulfill employment requirements, Monthly staff report.
2. General Services Agency: They will be working on the same level as before
3. Human Resources: Sam Gee will give updates of all TAP and Regular employees. Also, 2 youth Alameda county libraries was mentioned. Also, no updates as of yet about Civil Service 101-General training how to educate and apply for jobs (Tool Kit) possibly Summer 2019
4. Probation:
 - a) Contracts Units Employment Inclusivity mandates and staffing report is monthly on Demographics portion that will be tried on Google Form, that is to get feedback from vendors, you can add up to 10 people. If no changes, client will click NO button should send them directly to end of form to submit.

- b) Leadership meeting will be held on 02/18/19 for CDCR Education Program, discussed will be to get a count over the next 4 years, on inmate release services, the purpose is to get an idea of what type of re-entry service the client may need or would like to receive pre-release in order to get back into society.
 - c) Social services were unable to attend meeting with updates.
5. Community Based Organization updates: BOSS has 38 referrals since November and an open house on 84th and Macarthur Blvd., 20 new beds and it is gender specific Xerox and YEP and joined together and has opened up a commercial kitchen for the homeless transition they are providing 80 meals a day (40 breakfast, 40 lunch). Lao family has a training center located in Eastmont in Oakland. It is a resource for all family member sponsors (Everyone that is in the same household) can receive service. The CTE program has reported a total of 5 New Enrollees into program. As of now, there is a low count of referrals received since October. Chief also suggest that a rollup report to be presented at meetings for an idea of referrals received between vendors.
