WHAT IS THE YAC?

THE YAC CONSISTS OF 11 PAID YOUTH COUNCIL MEMBERS AGES 17-25 WHO HAVE BEEN IMPACTED BY THE JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM AND WHO HAVE A PASSION TO CREATE SYSTEMIC CHANGE



THE YAC CENTERS YOUTHS' LIVED EXPERIENCES AND NEEDS IN ORDER TO INFORM AND SERVE IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY.

YAC AIMS TO INCREASE THE INVOLVEMENT OF YOUTH VOICE IN THE ALAMEDA COUNTY JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM THAT AIDS YOUTH IN DEVELOPING THEIR LEADERSHIP AND ADVOCACY SKILLS.

YAC VISION

THE YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL ENVISIONS A COMMUNITY IN WHICH YOUTH WHO ARE SYSTEM IMPACTED HAVE ACCESS TO HOUSING, FOOD SECURITY, MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, AND JOB PLACEMENTS THAT PROVIDE A LIVABLE WAGE AND A PATHWAY TO EDUCATION IN ORDER TO SUPPORT THEIR PERSONAL GROWTH AND HEALING PROCESS.
