ROADWAY CLOSURE ON SUNOL-PLEASANTON ROAD

Alameda County Public Works Agency has a construction project that will require temporary closure of Pleasanton-Sunol Road to all vehicular traffic intermittently for approximately three weeks. Construction is scheduled to begin on Monday, July 12, 2004 and will continue intermittently until Thursday, July 29, 2004. Construction will occur between the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on the following dates:

One Lane Only Open on Pleasanton-Sunol Road

Monday, 7/12/04 through Friday, 7/16/04 at Mile Post 2.00 from 7:00 am-7:00 pm (Five Days). Only one lane will be open to traffic. Flaggers will direct traffic.

Complete Roadway Closure on Pleasanton-Sunol Road

Wednesday, 7/21/04 through Friday, 7/23/04 at Mile Post 2.00 from 7:00 am – 7:00 pm (Three Days)

Tuesday, 7/27/04 through Thursday, 7/29/04 at Mile Post 2.62 from 7:00 am – 7:00 pm (Three Days)

The construction schedule above is subject to change. Updates to this schedule will be posted to the Alameda County Public Works Agency's website: acgov.org/pwa as they occur.

Alameda County Public Works Agency is working on this construction project in partnership with the Pacific Locomotive Association (PLA). This project is funded by the State Transportation Program. The Agency has contracted with McGuire and Hester Construction Company to construct railroad-highway at-grade crossings on Pleasanton-Sunol Road at Mile Post 2.00 and Mile Post 2.62 (near Verona Road). The construction of additional at-grade crossing sites will provide a new interchange track connection between the Union Pacific Railroad and the County's railroad track (formerly owned by Southern Pacific Railroad). The County's right of way on this portion of the track is currently licensed to the PLA.
