Alameda County Director of Public Works, Donald J. LaBelle, presented for approval by the Board of Supervisors, plans and specifications for the Partial De-Silting of Zone 3A, Line D, Phase II, from Nimitz Freeway (I-880) to the Union Pacific Railroad Tracks, along Industrial Parkway West in Hayward and Union City, Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, California, Specification No. FC 3A-130.

The work to be done consists, in general, of excavating, loading, hauling and disposing off-site approximately 8,000 cubic yards of silt material from the channel.

The estimated construction cost of the project is \$300,000.00.

Plans and specifications may be secured by any prospective bidder from Room 100, Alameda County Public Works Agency, Contract Administration, 951 Turner Court, Hayward, CA 94545, for a non-refundable cost of \$5.00 (Volume 1) plus \$15.00 (Volume 2). Checks or money orders must be made payable to the **ALAMEDA COUNTY TREASURER**. If mailing of the material is desired, the bidder must provide a telephone number and street address. **NO POST OFFICE BOX NUMBERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

There is a mandatory pre-bid meeting required for all prime contractors. Interested subcontractors are invited and encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting is scheduled for July 6, 2004, at 10:00 a.m., at 951 Turner Court, Hayward, California. Bid Proposals from prime contractors who fail to attend this mandatory pre-bid meeting will be rejected.

Bids must be made on proposal forms obtained from the Public Works Agency and must be signed by the Bidder and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, certified check, certified without qualification and drawn on a solvent bank of the State of California or a National Bank doing business in the State of California and made

payable to COUNTY OF ALAMEDA, or a bid bond, prepared on the form provided by the County, to be retained by the County as agreed. Said deposit, cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond shall be in the amount of 10% of the amount bid. All bids will be received by the Director of Public Works until Tuesday, June 22, 2004, at 2:00 p.m.

The successful bidder must have a valid contractor's license, Classification "A" or "C-29," at the time the contract is awarded.
