Alameda County Director of Public Works, Donald J. LaBelle, on October 21, 2003, presented for approval by the Board of Supervisors, plans and specifications for the improvement of Line I, from Line E to UPRR, Fremont, California, Project No. FC 6-123.

The improvement is a portion of the Zone 6 Project of the Alameda County Flood Control District. The project, in general, consists of removing and replacing approximately 3,620 feet high chain-link fence with a three and a half-foot high reinforced concrete masonry block floodwall; constructing five (5) 15 feet wide, 60 feet long Class 2 aggregate base ramps; removing and replacing nine (9) modified drain inlets; and other miscellaneous items.

Work is expected to begin in January 2004, and will be completed by March 2004.

The estimated cost of the project is \$585,000.00. Funding of the project is provided by the Zone 6, Capital Project Fund.

Plans and Specifications may be secured by any prospective bidder from Room 100, Alameda County Public Works Agency, Contract Administration, 951 Turner Court, Hayward, CA 94545, Room 100, for a non-refundable cost of \$5.00 (Volume I) plus \$15.00 (Volume 2). Checks or money orders must be made payable to the **ALAMEDA COUNTY TREASURER**. If mailing of the material is desired, the bidder must provide a telephone number and street address NO POST OFFICE BOX NUMBERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

There is a mandatory pre-bid meeting required for all prime contractors. Interested sub-contractors are invited and encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting has been scheduled for Tuesday, November 4, 2003, at 10:00 a.m., at 951 Turner Court, Room 230A, Hayward, California. Bid Proposals from prime contractors that fail to attend this mandatory pre-bid meeting will be rejected.

Bids must be made on proposals obtained from the Public Works Agency and must be signed by the Bidder and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, certified check, certified without qualification and drawn on a solvent bank of the State of California or a National Bank doing business in the State of California and made payable to COUNTY OF ALAMEDA, or a bid bond, prepared on the form provided by the County, to be retained by the County as agreed. Said deposit, cashier's check, certified check or bid bond shall be in the amount of 10% of the amount bid. All bids will be received by the Director of Public Works until Tuesday, November 18, 2003.

The successful bidder must have a valid contractor's license, Classification A or C-29, at the time the contract is awarded.

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
