In an effort to promote livable and walkable communities, the Alameda County Public Works Agency partnered with Supervisor Miley's office and volunteers from the community and planted 128 Pistache trees along Castro Valley Boulevard. The trees were funded through a State of California grant and are part of the Community Beautification Program. The Public Works Agency continues to maintain these trees and has established a 3-year trimming cycle. The Agency asks that you not trim or remove any of these trees without first contacting the County. Twelve trees have already been damaged or trimmed without permits and one tree has been damaged to the point of requiring removal and replacement.
