Recently, you received a notice providing you the option to request a crossover ballot for the upcoming February Presidential Primary Election. The "Non-Partisan Voter's Request For Partisan Ballot" letter was mailed to you in error. The law permits qualified political parties to allow non-partisan voters to crossover and vote for their candidates (except for central committee members) in a Primary Election. The notice was intended to be mailed to only those voters who did not choose a qualified party when registering to vote.

While you received this letter in error it in no way affects your party affiliation or voter registration status. We appreciate and understand your concern and no further action is required on your behalf.
