#### I. <u>STATEMENT OF WORK</u>

#### A. <u>INTENT</u>

The intent of this RFQ is to solicit bids from qualified vendors who are interested in providing tree trimming and removal services for the PWA. The County intends to award a three (3) year contract with options to renew to the lowest qualified bidder(s).

#### B. <u>SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS</u>

- 2. Contractor's Services shall:
  - c. Include the prompt transport of all green waste to a composting facility or a transfer station that offers separate processing for green waste for composting

at Contractor's expense. Materials will be processed to their highest end use, e.g., composting versus landfill or for use as landfill cover.

d. Include contacting the Alameda County Agricultural Department and following guidelines as determined by that department, when working in areas where Sudden Oak Death (SOD) has been identified.

Comply with quarantine regulations set by the Alameda County Agricultural Department and the State of California when working in areas affected by Sudden Oak Death and Light Brown Apple Moth (LBAM). Regulations include, but are not limited to, ensuring that material is transported to a green waste processing facility that has been authorized by the County Agricultural Department to accept affected loads, ensuring vehicle payloads are tightly covered with a tarp or otherwise enclosing green waste material to prevent releases during transport, and ensuring equipment is cleaned after working in a contaminated zone so as to prevent cross contamination.
