WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 34191.3(a) provides that the Successor Agency is not permitted to dispose of any real property assets of the former RDA, except governmental use assets, until the Department of Finance ("DOF") approves the Successor Agency's long-range property management plan ("LRPMP") pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 34191.5; and
WHEREAS, on,, the DOF issued a Determination Letter approving the Successor Agency's LRPMP; and
WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 34191.3 further provides that a DOF-approved LRPMP governs and supersedes all other provisions relating to the disposition and use of real property assets of the former RDA; and
WHEREAS, the LRPMP designated certain real property located at , identified on the LRPMP as Asset ID No (the "Property");
and
WHEREAS, the Successor Agency intends to sell the Property to ("Purchaser") for a purchase price of, which
is equal to or greater than the value determined by an appraisal report dated,, prepared by; and
