Recommendation:

Adopt a Salary Ordinance amendment amending Section 3-13.18 in the Human Resource Services Department that provides additional compensation for Labor Relations Analyst when assigned overall Human Resource Service responsibilities for an operational Department.

Discussion/Findings:

We are amending Salary Ordinance Section 3-13.18 in the Human Resource Services Department, to extend the current provisions to additional staff that may be assigned overall Human Resource Service responsibilities for an operating Department to receive an additional five percent compensation. This amendment expands the assignment of overall responsibilities for Human Resource Services to more than one Department.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2015-2016
ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Article 3, of Ordinance Number 0-2015-54 of the County of Alameda, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-13.18 **Effective January 3, 2016**, employees in Job Code 0283PA and Job Code 0284PA, when assigned overall responsibilities for Human Resource Services for an Operating Department, shall be compensated an additional five percent of the base pay.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall take effect immediately, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, shall be published once with the names and of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the said County of Alameda.


