Subject: Salary Ordinance Amendment

Dear Board Members:

Recommendation:

Adopt a Salary Ordinance amendment to add a five percent footnote for two Agricultural and Standard Investigator positions in the Community Development Agency to compensate for the added responsibility of maintaining a Class A drivers license.

Discussion/Findings:

The Community Development Agency's Agricultural/Weights and Measures Department is mandated by the State of California to ensure that all commercial transactions based on weight, measure or count are performed on accurate and appropriate equipment.

Currently, there are two Agricultural and Standard Investigators that are assigned the responsibility of conducting vehicle and other heavy capacity scale inspections that require the use of Agricultural Weights and Measures "heavy capacity trucks". The incumbents are required to maintain a Class A California Driver's License in order to operate and perform heavy capacity scale inspections.

As this added responsibility is in addition to performing the typical duties of Agricultural and Standards Investigators, the Department is requesting that a five percent footnote be established for each of the two persons assigned to use the heavy capacity test truck to perform heavy capacity scale inspections.

Financing:

Funds are available in the 2014-2015 budget appropriation to pay the cost resulting from this action.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2014 - 2015 ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Article 3, of Ordinance Number 0-2014-47 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following note, to be effective <u>February 1, 2015.</u>

Section 3-12.90

Not to exceed two employees under Job Code 8418, 8419 and 8420, when assigned the responsibility of conducting inspections of trucks and other heavy capacity scales that require the use of Agricultural Weights Measures "heavy capacity truck" that require the incumbent to maintain a Class A California Driver's License shall receive an additional five percent compensation.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall take effect immediately, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the said County of Alameda.
