

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2013 - 2014
ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Article 3, of Ordinance Number of 0-2012-51 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following note, to be effective on the date shown.

3-15.21 Effective February 16, 2014, not to exceed one position under Job Code 9671NM, in the Department of Public Works, when serving as a Lead to other line staff in providing training and guidance in the area of electrical engineer and systems management repairs for the SCADA system, the incumbent shall receive an additional five percent compensation.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall take effect immediately, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, shall be published with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the said County of Alameda.
