SUBJECT: ACCEPT BID AND AWARD PROCUREMENT CONTRACT NO. 11873 TO RGW CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR THE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON PATTERSON PASS ROAD IN THE VICINITY OF MILEPOST MARKER 6.4, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA; SPECIFICATION NO. 2092; IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,470,055.00

RECOMMENDATION:

That your Honorable Board:

1. Accept the bid and award Procurement Contract No. 11873 to RGW Construction, Inc. (Principal: William S. Stewart, President; Location: Livermore, CA), in the amount of \$1,470,055.00, based on the unit prices stated in its bid proposal for the project, the Safety Improvements on Patterson Pass Road in the Vicinity of Milepost Marker 6.4, Alameda County, California; Specification No. 2092;
2. Authorize the President of the Board to sign said contract upon review by County Counsel, said work to be completed within sixty (60) calendar days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed; and
3. Approve the encumbrance of an additional \$147,005.50 as a Supplemental Work Allowance (SWA) for a total encumbered amount of \$1,617,060.50 for the project, and authorize the Director of Public Works to approve contract changes as necessary against the SWA.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Your Board previously approved this project for advertisement on 3/10/15. The project consists, in general, of providing a traffic control system; providing construction area signs; furnishing and implementing water pollution control plans; notifying and coordinating with local residents, businesses, and authorities; furnishing and applying water; sawcutting; removal of existing base and surfacing; installing (SKT) Midwest Guardrail System, removal of and installing pipe culverts, concrete lined ditches and rock slope protection system; removal of fence and installing barbed wire fence; roadway excavation; furnishing, placing, and compacting Type A hot mix asphalt; furnishing, placing, and compacting aggregate base; cold planning existing pavement and overlay with Type A hot mix asphalt; installing pavement markers and thermoplastic traffic stripe and; installing roadside signs; removal and disposal of excess and waste material; and the cleaning of the site at the end of the job.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS:

The project was advertised in accordance with established Construction Outreach Program procedures, which include:

- *Advertisement in seven (7) general publications and eight (8) trade or minority publications;*
- *Posting of contract documents in 23 Plan Rooms and/or trade organizations;*
- *A pre-bid conference was held for interested contractors, with attendance at the conference required for all general contractors, and encouraged for subcontractors. The conference was attended by five (5) contractors;*

On 5/6/15, two (2) bids were received and opened. Table 1 shows an abstract of the bids received. The bids will be forwarded to you under separate cover.

The bids were reviewed by Public Works staff and found to be in order. The low bidder, RGW Construction, Inc., a local firm, exceeded the DBE participation goals, with 10.44% DBE participation, and it is recommended that the contract be awarded to RGW Construction, Inc. The prime contractor and its subcontractors will be required to utilize the County's Compliance System to ensure labor and business utilization compliance.

FINANCING:

The funds for this project are budgeted and available in the Road Department Budget, ORG Nos. 270401 and 270402, Account 610290, (Professional & Specialized Services - Construction). There will be no impact on the General Fund.

The County of Alameda, a political subdivision of the State of California, acting by and through its Board of Supervisors, hereinafter called COUNTY, and RGW Construction Inc., hereinafter called CONTRACTOR, hereby agree as follows:

1. It has been determined by the Board of Supervisors of COUNTY that it is necessary to secure all labor, material, equipment, mechanical workmanship, transportation and services for accomplishment of the project described as follows:

**THE ROADWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON PATTERSON PASS ROAD IN THE VICINITY OF
MILEPOST MARKER 6.4, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA**

2. The plans, specifications, and CONTRACTOR'S bid proposal for the total bid price of \$1,470,055.00 said figure for the purpose of comparing bids only, exact payment for the job to be based on the unit prices, as stated in CONTRACTOR'S bid proposal, submitted May 6, 2015 for the aforesaid project, now on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Construction Department, Public Works Agency, are hereby referred to as a more definite and distinct description of the work to be performed under this contract, and are hereby made a part of this contract the same as though fully set forth herein.

3. CONTRACTOR agrees and contracts with COUNTY to commence and complete the work of the aforesaid project in a skillful and substantial manner to the satisfaction of COUNTY in accordance with the plans and specifications for the project at the prices as set forth in CONTRACTOR'S bid proposal and within the time limit established by the contract specifications.

4. CONTRACTOR agrees that said CONTRACTOR and all pertinent subcontractors employed on the project will pay all employees involved in the work not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages for the day, legal holiday, and overtime work as set forth within the appropriate General Prevailing Wage Determinations made by the Director of Industrial Relations, State of California, in accordance with Section 1770 of the Labor Code of the State of California. Said wage determinations are on file with the Director of Public Works, County of Alameda.

5. Sections 1775, 1776, and 1777.5 of the Labor Code apply to this contract. Section 1775 covers penalties to be assessed CONTRACTOR for failure to pay prevailing wage rates; Section 1776 sets forth the responsibility of CONTRACTOR to insure maintenance of accurate payroll records for both CONTRACTOR and any pertinent subcontractors; Section 1777.5 covers the employment of properly registered apprentices, and places the responsibility for compliance with this Section with CONTRACTOR for all apprenticeable occupations.

6. In accordance with Part 7, Chapter 1, Article 3 of the Labor Code, (a) eight hours labor constitutes a legal day's work; (b) work performed by employees of CONTRACTOR or pertinent subcontractors in excess of eight hours per day, and forty hours during any one week, shall be permitted upon compensation for all hours worked in excess of eight hours per day at a rate not less than one and one-half times the basic rate of pay; and (c) CONTRACTOR shall pay twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) each calendar day to COUNTY for each worker employed in the execution of the contract by CONTRACTOR or by any pertinent subcontractor where such worker or workers are required or permitted to work more than eight hours in any one calendar day and forty hours in any one calendar week in violation of said Article 3 of the Labor Code.

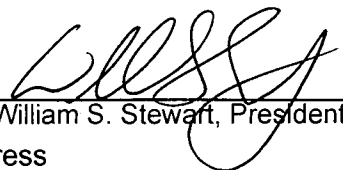
7. In accordance with Section 1861 of the Labor Code, CONTRACTOR hereby furnishes the following certification: "I am aware of the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code which requires every employer to be insured against liability for worker's compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that code, and I will comply with such provisions before commencing the performance of the work of this contract."
