**Subject: Salary Ordinance Amendment**

Dear Board Members:

**Recommendation:**

That your Board adopt a Salary Ordinance amendment amending an existing footnote, in the Sheriff's Office.

**Discussion/Findings:**

Your representatives and representatives of SEIU Local 1021 have agreed to amend Section 3-17.40 of the Salary Ordinance. The current language of the footnote limits the compensation to no more than three persons in the Sheriff Technician position. However, the current needs of the Department require more than the three persons in the Sheriff's Technician classification be assigned to the Coroner's Bureau. Therefore, we are increasing the number of persons eligible for the footnote to twelve.

**Financing:**

Funds are available in the 2013-2014 Budget appropriation to pay the cost of this action.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2013 - 2014  
ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

**Article 3** of Ordinance Number 0-2012-51 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended to read as follows, effective on the date shown:

3-17.40 Effective November 10, 2013, not to exceed a total of twelve persons occupying a position under Job Code 8755, Sheriff's Technician, when assigned to the Coroner's Bureau, shall receive an additional five percent compensation.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall take effect immediately, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the said County of Alameda.
