That your Board adopt a Salary Ordinance amendment to amend one footnote in the Sheriff's Office and add one footnote in the Community Development Agency.

Discussion/Findings:

We are recommending the amendment of one footnote in the Sheriff's Office to allow for one additional Sergeant to be compensated an additional five percent for overseeing the canine unit, which has now expanded into two separate units that operate independently.

In addition, the Community Development Agency has requested an additional five percent compensation for a Deputy Sealer of Weights and Measures when performing statistical analysis of crop production data and oversight of agricultural inspection activity for staff located in the Oakland office specifically related to wholesale produce market inspections, retail egg handlers and farmers market inspection programs.

Financing:

Funds are available in the 2009-2010 budget appropriation to pay the costs of these actions.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE 2009 - 2010
ALAMEDA COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Article 3 of Ordinance Number 0-2009-51 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the amendment thereof of the following note to be effective on the date shown.

3-17.38 Effective October 6, 2007, not to exceed two persons occupying a position under Job Code 8617, when assigned to supervise a Canine Unit, shall receive an additional 5 percent compensation.

SECTION II

Article 3 of Ordinance Number 0-2009-51 of the County of Alameda is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following note to be effective on the date shown.

3-21.81 Effective December 28, 2009, not to exceed one employee occupying a position in Job Code 8435, in the Agricultural/Weights and Measures Department, when assigned and performing duties related to the oversight of agricultural statistics, fruit vegetable and egg standardization inspections and pesticide investigations, shall receive an additional five percent compensation.

SECTION III

This ordinance shall take effect immediately, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the said County of Alameda.
