### **VI. Measure D – Fire Safety Bond Ballot Measure**

Fire Chief David Rocha, Alameda County Fire Department, presented a PowerPoint presentation on Measure D the Fires Safety Bond.

Alameda County, the County Board of Supervisors placed Measure D, the Alameda County Fire Department's Fire Safety Bond, on the March 3, 2020 ballot to address inadequate fire facilities in the unincorporated area.

The measure would authorize the Fire Department to issue up to \$90 million in bonds to repair, replace and upgrade outdated fire stations. The estimated cost of Measure D is \$0.01.6 cents per \$100 of assessed property value, which is approximately \$63 per parcel for the average parcel in the unincorporated areas. This measure will only be voted on by unincorporated area residents.

A motion was made by Chuck Moore and seconded by Shannon Killebrew to support the Measure D Fire Safety Bond Ballot Measure.
