1. **CALL TO ORDER** – Member DeGrange called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Derek Johnson commented that the Agenda link on the website was not working

Michael Miller spoke about his plans for the use and improvements to the Cerny Building, which will be renamed Sunol Town Center

Alameda County Sheriff's Office – Marc Petrini reported that 28 calls for service were received, no major incidents. A white truck has been spotted filling up a water trailer at a hydrant on Kilkare and the Sheriff's office is looking for additional information on the vehicle

Alameda County Fire Department – Bonnie Terra reported that 28 calls for service were received, 3 calls were for fires – 2 vehicle fires and 1 small fire in an animal corral. A heat emergency is expected to impact Sunol increasing the danger for fires and heat related illnesses

Sunol Boundary/Mapping Project – Member Beemiller reported that a meeting is scheduled for Thursday, 6/17/21 to review maps/materials with Alameda County Planning Director Albert Lopez

Member DeGrange commented that a letter was sent to CalTrans stating the Council's disappointment in the documentation received from CalTrans in response to the Council's public records request

Member Beemiller inquired about resuming in-person Sunol Citizen Advisory Council meetings as public facilities were starting to open for business

Chris Miley commented that there have been many inquiries about resuming in-person meetings. No dates have been set for resuming in-person meetings. CalOSHA and other requirements need to be reviewed prior to County

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facilities opening to the public. Chris will research which County and public facilities could be used for in-person meeting sites

Member Dentinger commented that narrowing the Council's focus to one or two key concerns related to CalTrans would be more effective
