Randy Morris, Assistant Agency Director, Adult and Aging Medical Services, Rachel Metz, Policy Director, Health Care Services Agency and Jessica Woodward, Health Care Services Agency, presented a PowerPoint presentation on the Agency's Health Care Eligibility and Enrollment.

The presentation included the current status of eligibility, enrollment and retention.
