

## Ivan Cruz Memorial Scholarship Fund

In November of 2014, Ivan Cruz, a 14-year old boy riding a scooter, passed away after being struck by a hit-and-run driver in Ashland. This scholarship is in honor of Ivan Cruz. He was known and loved by many people in the Ashland and Cherryland communities. He is remembered as a happy teenager who was always riding his scooter, or skateboard. He especially liked to do this at the Jack Holland Sr. Park, which is next to the REACH Ashland Youth Center. He loved being at the Ashland Youth Complex and benefited from all the people and services that supported him. Ivan reminds us that youth are our community's greatest asset. Their hopes, needs, creativity and dreams should serve as our compass. We believe that when

youth thrive, so does our future.

This scholarship is for juniors in high school to young adults (16-24 years old) who are planning on or are in college/vocational school and have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA. Applicants are required to participate in the Ashland Cherryland 5K Fun Run and have performed some community pride/service volunteer hours. The Ivan Cruz Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to three youth individuals. Each scholarship is \$500 and can be used toward tuition and textbooks.
