December 23, 2021 – January 21, 2022**

THE ALAMEDA COUNTY HOME CONSORTIUM INVITES PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING THE ALAMEDA COUNTY HOME CONSORTIUM SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE FY21 ACTION PLAN

Jurisdictions which are eligible to receive federal funding from housing and community development programs administered by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) are required to prepare a Consolidated Plan and annual Action Plans which outlines needs, strategies, priorities, and programs for the expenditure of federal funds for housing and community development activities. The Action Plan also combines the applications and reporting requirements for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) formula programs.

In September 2021, HUD released HOME American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) funds to Alameda County Housing and Community Development (HCD) Department.

The purpose of this notice is for Alameda County HCD to do a substantial amendment to its FY21 Action Plan to add a new category of funding- the HOME ARP funds. HCD is proposing to utilize the funds as local matching funds for HOME Consortium jurisdictions applying for the State of California Homekey funds for homeless housing assistance.

The Draft FY21 Action Plan Substantial Amendment will be available for inspection on HCD's Website: <https://www.acgov.org/cda/hcd/> beginning **December 23, 2021 on the HCD website. The public review period will end on January 21, 2022.** A public hearing will be held to receive comments on the Substantial Amendment to the FY21 Action Plan on **Tuesday, January 11, 2022, 6 p.m.** The Hearing will be held via a Zoom meeting at the following link:
