- 1) Report-out: August EJ Community Workshop—Member comments:
 - Next time, consider including an **end-of-meeting survey** after community meetings to learn how people found out about the meeting: helpful to know which outreach methods are most effective
 - Interesting to see the contrasting **community viewpoints about the presence of law enforcement**—some community members indicate that law enforcement presence makes them feel unsafe, and some community members are calling for increased law enforcement presence
 - People speaking out in favor of a Sheriff's substation in Cherryland may be reacting positively to the hyper-local approach they're seeing with our local LE representatives—the way our local LE shows up in community is important
 - May be reacting to ideas of a "Polis Station" that have been under discussion locally—a movement to reorient police stations into neighborhood hubs that strengthen local communities
 - Glad to see recommendations for a **Health in All Policy**—an approach to public policies across sectors that systematically takes into account the health and health systems implications of decisions, seeks synergies and avoids harmful health impacts, in order to improve community health and health equity
 - Include **multi-use trails** on this list—support for these projects should be included in the County's bike/ped plans and transportation planning
 - Include programming/policy to support **home-based daycare**
- 2) Guest Speaker Leigha Schmidt: the City of Hayward's EJ Element—Member comments:
 - Clear **opportunity for cross-jurisdictional EJ collaboration** because of shared geography of EJ census tracts, shared measures that include agencies like HARD, County Health Department
 - Consider development of a cross-jurisdictional EJ Commission/Committee
 - Can the **County's EJ Element call out cross-jurisdictional collaboration** for items like air pollution, transportation, HARD collab?
 - What is the process for working with external agencies that have measures in a City/County EJ element, such as HARD? Think about how to best collaborate with outside agencies for joint implementation measures
 - Air District (BAAQMD) has engaged in initial conversations about **cross-jurisdictional collaboration on air quality issues**
