Ability to change adjustment factors	Pilot Counties are allowed to request changes to any and all adjustment factors. No Pilot County has made such request so far. Ratio between 3 and 4 year olds in CSPP	Pilot Counties do not need to follow the requirement of ½ of the children enrolled in CSPP to be 4 year olds.	Eliminates the requirement of at least ½ of the children enrolled in CSPP to be 4 year olds.	Requires of at least ½ of the children enrolled in CSPP to be 4 year olds.
State reimbursement for staff training	Pilot Counties are not authorized to request State reimbursement for staff training.
