DRDP for Beginners

The Desired Results Development Profile (DRDP) is an assessment tool developed by the California Department of Education for young children and their families. This tool is used to inform instruction and program development and is managed through teacher observations, family observations, and examples of children's work.

The DRDP provides guidelines for teachers to observe, document, and reflect a child's knowledge and skills in every day environments. It is a recommended practice for early childhood assessment. This training will support child care providers in having a better understanding of how to plan curriculum around individual and group needs. The goals of the DRDP are to make sure children are personally and socially competent, are effective learners, have physical and motor competence, and are safe and healthy.
