**ECE Planning Council Steering Committee:**  
The Alameda County Early Care and Education Planning Council advises and makes recommendations to policymakers to ensure that all children and families have access to quality child care that educates children and enriches their lives.

**Executive Committee:**  
The Executive Committee reviews strategic planning objectives during months when the Planning Council does not meet; makes timely decisions in between Planning Council meetings.

SUB-COMMITTEES

**Public Policy:**  
Monitors and develops early care and education legislation, policies and regulations that impact children, families and child care providers. Guides the Council's advocacy agenda and action, including positions on legislation.

**State Contractors' Group:**  
Works to bring all State contracted child care programs together (Alternative payment, Center-based, State Preschool AB 172, Latchkey, Handicapped, Campus) to share resources, tips and advocate for improvements in the subsidy systems for Alameda County

**Early Care and Education Quality Committee:**  
The Early Care and Education Committee's purpose is to improve the quality of early care and education of children, birth to five, by considering issues and making recommendations on programs impacting children in early care and education programs.

**ECE Data Committee:**  
This Task Force supports the annual identification of zip code priorities as well as special project such as the County-wide annual web, based provider survey and County needs assessment.

**Local Investment in Child Care (LINCC) Advisory Committee:**  
LINCC guides ongoing assessment and analysis of how child care contributes to the economy in Alameda County and identifies specific ways to improve and enhance that contribution.
