CreAting fun provider trading program

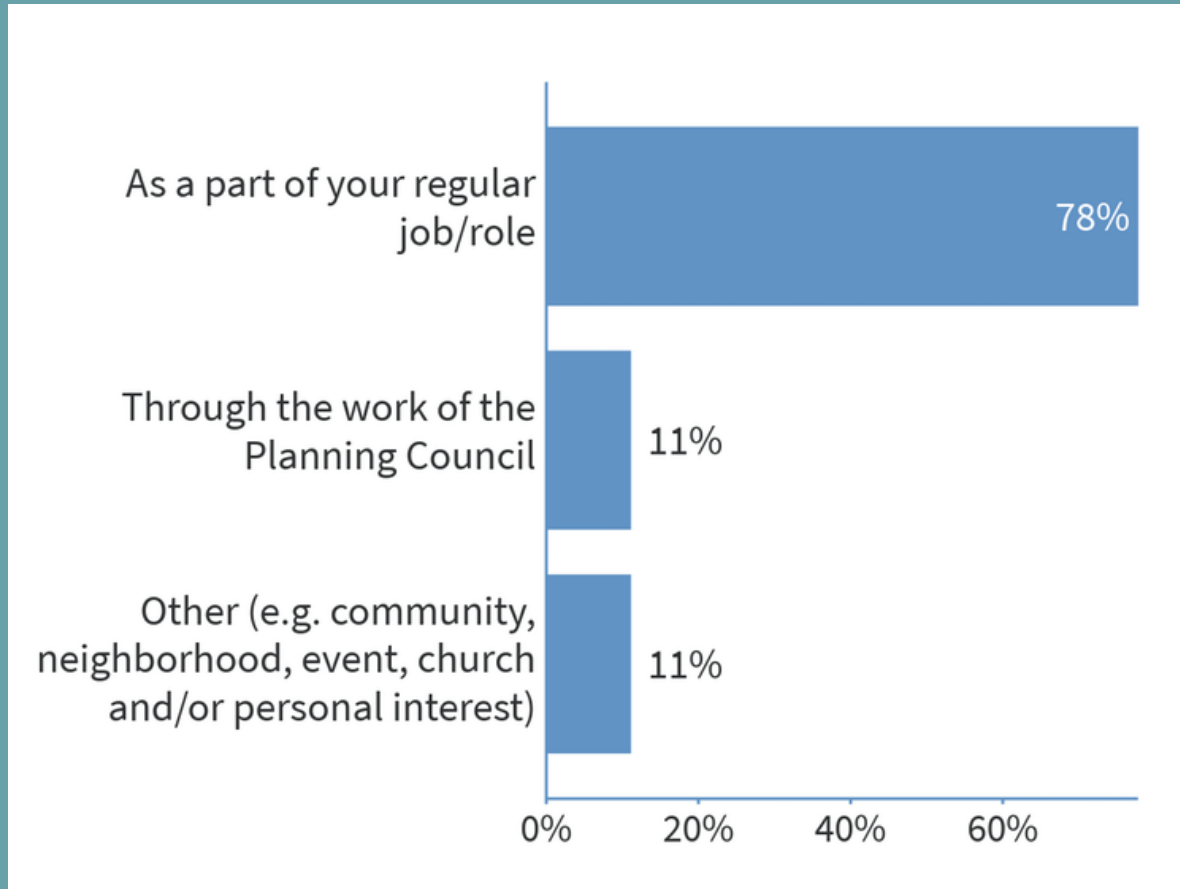

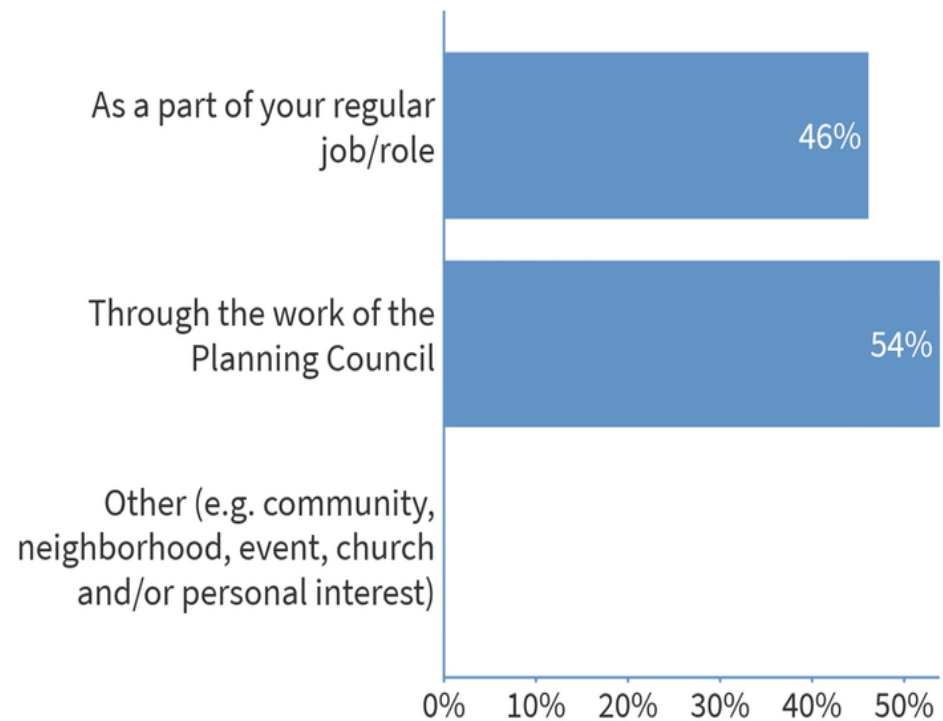
