Responses to Written Questions

- Q1) Are there any Court required reports and/or are there any specific requirements for reporting to the Court having jurisdiction by the ADA Monitor as part of the settlement agreement?
- A1) No there are no required reports to the Court only to the settling parties. However reports to the parties may be presented to the Court.**
- Q2) Our office and professional standard of care for the access plan/peer review process is to complete a final back check(s) of corrected plans, preferably in person with the design professional/team as appropriate, to ensure full compliance. We then issue a letter/statement of acceptance of the plans and specification as being in compliance with the applicable accessibility codes and regulations. We also require review of any change drawings issued during bid/construction that relate to accessibility or elements have accessible features/requirements. Is this the anticipated process in the scope of work for the project related to access plan review?
- A2) This process is generally consistent with the monitoring program although the precise details will be determined in contract negotiations and may change based on the project delivery method (e.g. Job Order Contracting, Design-Bid-Build, Design-Build or Owner delivered).**
