1. Attachment 1, Photograph: A photograph of a sample concrete aggregate has been provided for illustrative reference.

Attachment 2, Laydown sketch: A hand and computer-annotated version of Sheet T3 dated 11/18/16 is included showing "staging area for construction," "location of temporary ramp," "construction laydown area," and "service road for concrete truck."

4. Questions/Responses-Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference

Below are the questions submitted by attendees at the January 4, 2017 Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference. Responses to these questions are included in this Addendum 2, as follows:

- Q1. Can you please issue documents per Spec Section 00 31 19-2.4.1 and 2.4.3?
- A1. Per Section 00 31.19, Subsection 2.4.1, GSA will provide to the best of its ability, if possible, any available record documents for reference to the contracted G.C. The G.C. must do its own diligence per Section 00 31 19 as to the existing field conditions. Under Section 00 31 19, Subsection 2.4.3, GSA will conduct hazardous materials due diligence as per standard practice and will provide hazardous materials reports and documentation as specified, where required and as appropriate.
- Q2. Is Document 00 41 13 the correct bid form to be used, and shows (3) alternates but only one could be found on drawing T1 alt. note #1?
- A2. Yes Document 00 41 13 is the correct bid form. There is only one Alternate as shown on Drawing T1, Note 1. Therefore, the space on the bid form for Alternates 2 and 3 in Document 00 41 13 should be marked, "N/A" for purposes of this bid.
- Q3. (a) Please provide site layout drawing showing extent of contractor provided security fencing and also the extent and location of the owner provided laydown areas. (b) What are the requirements for the type of contractor temporary fencing?
- A3. A layout has been provided as shown in Attachment 2 in this Addendum 2 for job site security fencing, and the extent and location of allowable laydown area. The Contractor shall provide standard field grade security fencing appropriate for a project of this size, scope and configuration, to secure Contractor's job site.
- Q4. Reference is made to item 3.11 Lime stabilization in section 31 23 00. If lime stabilization is to be included in the bid proposal, please indicate the percentage of lime required and the depth required for the application.
- A4. Lime stabilization would be "as needed" based on wet weather conditions. Specific requirements would be issued depending on the field conditions.
- Q5. Reference is made to drawing A1.2, new bollards and sleeves. Please provide additional information-Bollard size, foundation design-depth and diameter.
- A5. Bollard and sleeve size and diameter are to match existing at the base of the existing ramp. Depth to match existing or 2'-0", whichever is deeper.

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- Q6. Can you please clarify the color of the colored concrete?
- A6. The color requirement is stated in Detail 2/A1.3 and Specification Section 32 05 23, 2.6A.
- Q7. Please clarify exposed aggregate finish. Is this a natural wash or seeded aggregate? If so, what type of aggregate (size, color) and then washed. Please see attached A1.3 with notes.
- A7. Exposed Aggregate finish is seeded and washed. Aggregate is to be river rock, approximately 3/8" max size, gray mix with some dark/black. See Attachment 1, in this Addendum 2 with photo for reference as an example. Architect will work with Contractor to achieve best match to photo.
- Q8. Can the curbs be a solid pour and an "L" bar placed for the SOG? Please see attached detail with notes.
- A8. We do not recommend the option as proposed in your sketch. An expansion joint separates the curb from the slab edge.
- Q9. Will a water supply/hookup be provided by GSA?
- A9. Yes, this can be arranged through GSA for the Contractor at the appropriate time of the project staging and can tap into the irrigation system for reclaimed water or the potable system as necessary.
- Q10. Please clarify the logistics for concrete trucks and concrete pumps. It appears that all concrete will need to be pumped from the parking lot. Will there be a designated area that will be closed for pour days and delivery days of material?
- A10. Concrete trucks can access the site via the Service Road that runs along the perimeter of the site and will allow for the weight of the equipment. Provision will be necessary for control of pedestrian traffic that crosses the road during the work which can be done with flaggers.
- 5. Project Clarification regarding Pre-Qualified Bidders
 - Three (3) General Contractors were previously qualified by GSA to submit a bid for this construction project. All three (3) of these General Contractors attended the Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference held on 1/4/2017 but one later declined to submit bids. Therefore, this project going forward and this Addendum 2 posting is for the two (2) remaining pre-qualified General Contractors: B. Bros Construction and W.A. Thomas Construction. See attached their contact information, should there be any subcontractors who would like to contact them for subcontracting opportunities.




