No Modified Sections

Responses to Written Questions

- Q1) Do the General Contractors need to be pre-qualified?
- A1) Yes, using this current ongoing process.
- Q2) Do the Subcontractors need to be pre-qualified?
- A2) No, subcontractors are not required to be prequalified to bid. Further, there is no requirement of competition with subcontractors. A GC can work with whomever. Competition is at prime contract level.
- Q3) Any Project Labor Agreement (PLA) or Project Stabilization Agreement (PSA) requirements?
- A3) Known as Project Stabilization/Community Benefit Agreement (PSCBA) in County of Alameda, as it involves community benefit items as well as PLA, the governing documents are posted with this RFQ as section 00 73 49.
- Q4) Are structural insulated panels (SIP) still on the project?
- A4) SIPs are no longer specified in this project. The project has been re-engineered for conventional.
- Q5) In light of recent bidding by prior CMR, what is the likelihood this project will be built?
- A5) County has funding and is actively bidding this project as it needs to be built.
- Q6) Is this a LEED project?
- A6) Yes LEED Silver is required. Awarded GC will be required to coordinate LEED submittals pertinent to construction issues.
- Q7) Project selected on Base Bid or Base Bid + Alternates?
- A7) County is still assessing the basis for selection and will be clarified in upcoming RFP.
- Q8) Is project CAD or REVIT? Will it be available to GC?
- A8) Project is in REVIT and can be made available to GC, with appropriate waiver by architects.
- Q9) Is there a Local Hire requirement?
- A9) Yes, as outlined in requirements for Enhanced Construction Opportunity Process (ECOP) in document 00 22 19 and Project Stabilization/Community Benefit Agreement (PSCBA) in document 00 73 49. Both are attached to this RFQ.

- Q10) Is a site office for owner's rep required?
- A10) No, but single office should be able to support weekly meetings.
- Q11) How will extent of artwork be described in documents?
- A11) Section 00 73 73.01 of the project specification will describe the public art work and how it is to be implemented.
- Q12) Regarding the Scoring shown on pages 44 47 of the prequalification is the General Contractor required to fill this out?
- A12) This will be completed by the staff evaluating each submitted qualifications package. We provided this so that each submitter understand how the scoring will be tallied
- Q13) X The instructions state that 6 copies and 1 flash drive must be submitted. Do you require 6 copies of our 2016 financial and a pdf of it on the flash drive as well? Or just one original?
- A13) We only need a single copy of your paper financials and no scanned version.
