Item#1

Responses to Written Questions: All questions and answers apply to Santa Rita Jail (SRJ), Juvenile Justice Center (JJC), and Glenn Dyer Detention Facility (GDDF) Projects:

- Q1) Does the engineer have to be present during the pre-submittal conference?
- A1) Yes, in order to qualify for phase II request for proposal for one or all of the projects, the engineer is required to attend that meeting.
- Q2) Do all engineers possess valid and current professional licenses for the services for which they intend to provide on the Project?
- A2) Yes, a valid and current professional license is required for each service that is provided on this project.
- Q3) Is the Engineer to have current workers' compensation insurance policy as required by the Labor Code or is legally self-insured pursuant to Labor Code section 3700 et seq.?
- A3) Yes
- Q4) Is the Engineer required to attach a copy of its most current reviewed or audited financial statement with accompanying notes and supplemental information, as well as reviewed or audited financial statements with accompanying notes and supplemental information for the past 3 years?
- A4) Yes, in order to qualify for phase II request for proposal, the engineer is required to attach their most current reviewed or audited financial statement with accompanying notes and supplemental information, as well as reviewed or audited financial statements with accompanying notes and supplemental information for the past 3 years. A financial statement that is not either reviewed or audited is not acceptable. A letter verifying availability of a line of credit is not a substitute for the required financial statement.
