


The Project includes the construction of three (3) large recreation areas, seven (7) small recreation areas, and the conversion of two quasi yards into four (4) smaller quasi yards. The scope includes, but is not limited to:

- anti-climb fencing on posts
- chain-link fence ceiling
- detention grade plumbing fixtures
- concrete masonry unit walls
- concrete floor slabs & striping
- detention grade site furnishings, tables, chairs and equipment
- sports equipment
- security cameras & related work

- Site is located at 5325
   Broder Blvd. in Dublin, CA.
- Installation of new outdoor recreation spaces and creating two new Quasi-Yards
- 1 Small & Large Outdoor Rec Areas Max
- 2 Quasi Yards at HU1 & HU2
- Blectrical Room / Panel 2HA at HU2 adjacent to Quasi Yard; Basement Tech Room at HU2
- Basement Tech Room at HU1
- 5 Electrical Room / Panel 8HA at HU8 adjacent to Quasi Yard; Basement Tech Room at HU8

- Submit a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) signed by all firms requesting a link to the Technical Specifications and Drawings (Document 00 11 16A).
  - A link to the full set of drawings and specifications will ONLY be e-mailed to firms with signed NDAs.
  - Subcontractors for a particular Prime Contractor are covered under the respective Prime Contractors NDA.
- Submit a site clearance form for ALL staff intended to attend the Pre-Bid Site Visit (Document 00 73 13A).
- The last day to submit an NDA & Site Clearance Form is October 25, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.
- General Contractors submit signed and sealed bids by 12/13/23 at 2:00 pm.

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## Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) & Site Clearance Forms Instructions

### Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) form (Document 00 11 16A):

- Must be completed and submitted to receive drawings and specifications.
- The form must be deemed complete by the County.
- Requestor will receive a copy of the drawings and specifications within 48 hours from receipt of the form.

- **Due Date: October 25, 2023.** You are encouraged to submit this form as soon as possible to allow ample time for review of the drawings and specifications.

### Alameda County Sheriff's Office Detention and Corrections Security Clearance form (Document 00 73 13A):

- Must be completed and submitted to participate in the Site Visit.
- Must be completed by each person who intends to participate in the Site Visit. If a group wishes to participate, every member of the group must submit a form.
- It is recommended that each submitter be candid about possible past arrests or convictions, as stated on the form. Past arrests and convictions are not automatic grounds for denial; however, their concealment is.
- Due date: October 25, 2023.

### Rules / Requirements for Pre-Bid Site Walk

- Pre-Bid Site Walk (non-mandatory) is on 11/14/23 from 10:00A.M. 11:30A.M.
- Approved Site Clearance Forms are required for all attendees
- Park in the Visitors Parking lot and proceed up the ramp to the Media Room off the Visitors Lobby (door to the immediate left upon entering the lobby) where the site-walk briefing will be held at 10:00A.M.
- Once in the Media Room, approved Site Clearance Forms will be confirmed. Please allow time for this process in advance of the 10:00A.M. start of the site walk briefing.
