Can you provide a list of referral resources currently used by the City of San Leandro?

Answer:

The City of San Leandro works with many local nonprofits to fund services for those experiencing homelessness, mental health challenges, domestic violence, and general needs assistance. Partners/services include but are not limited to:

- Winter Warming Center. The City partners with Housing Consortium of the East Bay and First United Methodist Church of San Leandro to host Winter Warming Center. For FY23-24, Winter Shelter is open when temperatures are below 40 degrees and/or there is a 50% or higher chance of rain.
- The City of San Leandro provides funding to the following non-profits for providing supportive services to unsheltered populations: Building Futures with Women and Children, Davis Street Family Resource Center, Housing Consortium of the East Bay, and Ruby's Place
- Additional partners include but are not limited to Davis Street Family Resource Center, Family Violence Law Center, Safe Alternatives to Violence Environments, and San Leandro Boys & Girls Club.
