Brief Scope: TI work in existing, unfinished room (115) originally design to be dog kennels.

- The room will be divided into (2) rooms (exam and surgical rooms) with a new wall and door/windows between.
- Concrete topper (Ardex or sim.) and epoxy paint (Prime Coat or sim.) to be added over existing concrete subfloor.
- Existing CMU walls to be painted with epoxy paint (Prime Coat or Sim.).
- Existing wood framed walls to be dry-walled and painted.
- Exam room ceiling to receive insulation and finished with drywall and paint.
- Surgery room ceiling to receive insulation and finished with suspended ceiling per existing room 113.
- New phone and data lines required at new desk area.
- Existing capped plumbing supply to be utilized and possibly moved to align with new room layout (sink and 'wet' exam table).
- Existing floor drains to be utilized for sink and 'wet' exam table drains (feasibility TBD).
- New electrical subpanel (size TBD) is required for the addition of wall switches, outlets and ceiling fixtures.
 - Coordinate power requirements with high tech exam and surgical equipment (list proved, note dedicated circuit requirements).
 - Electrical OK to be EMT conduit, surface mounted to walls.
 - Engineering assessment and shop drawings required for new electrical run from Elec.
 Room 129 to Exam Room 115.
- It is the intent that the existing HVAC supply (capped) be extended into room(s).
 - Current system allows for continuation of supply air and addition of an exhaust fan (1500 cfm).
 - o Engineering assessment and shop drawings required.
 - Rebalancing of HVAC required.
- Sprinkler modifications as required. * Requires drawings & City Fire Marshal permit.
