Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame Now Accepting 2024 Nominations

Oakland, CA - The Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame is now accepting nominations for its class of 2024 inductees. The Hall of Fame was established in 1993 to celebrate local women making a difference in the diverse communities of Alameda County, and to preserve their legacies in the County archives.

Nominations are being accepted online through February 29, 2024 at acgov.org/whof in the categories of: Business & Professions, Culture & Art, Community Service, Education, Emerging Leaders, Environmental, Health, Justice, Non-Traditional, Philanthropy, Science-Tech-Engineering, and Sports & Athletics. Up to twelve inductees will be selected for induction by a panel of judges.

Inductees will be honored at a special luncheon and inductee ceremony on Saturday, May 4, 2024, at The Club at Castlewood in Pleasanton. Through this event and other community activities, the Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame raises funds to aid organizations dedicated to assisting and supporting women and families within Alameda County.
