Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame Now Accepting Inductee Nominations Deadline Extended

Oakland, CA - The Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame is extending the deadline for nominations for its class of 2025 inductees. The Hall of Fame, established in 1993, honors local women making a meaningful impact in the diverse communities of Alameda County and preserves their legacies in the County archives.

Inductee nominations can be submitted online in the following categories: Business & Professions, Culture & Art, Community Service, Education, Emerging Leaders, Environment, Health, Justice, Non-Traditional Careers, Philanthropy, Science-Technology-Engineering, and Sports & Athletics. The new nomination deadline is 11:59 PM on Monday, February 17, 2025.

Up to twelve inductees and four youth scholarship recipients will be selected by a panel of judges and honored at a special luncheon and awards ceremony on **Saturday**, **April 26**, **2025**, at The Club at Castlewood, in Pleasanton. Through this event and other community activities, the Alameda County Women's Hall of Fame raises funds to support local organizations that serve women and families throughout Alameda County.
